Item #1: Motion by Red Elk approving consent agenda items A-N. Second by Runyan.

Announcements by Mayor and Council:

Mayor reminded this weekend we will be having the spring clean up at the lagoons Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Stated that he was asked about tree limbs would be accepted at this event. No absolute answer was given to the question.

Mr. Lyons stated that he wanted to thank the street department for their hard work and culverts that were placed around Wildflower for the storm waters.

Mayor Brown stated that Mr. Mark Hill, Sr. is retiring and gave him a plaque for his dedication to the city and will surely be missed by all of us.

Citizens Participation:

New Pastor of the Assembly of God Church stated that on May 23, 2026 they were going to have block party to feed the youth of the city and wanted to be able to block off the road between 5th and 6th Street from 5-10 p.m. He also asked if maybe they could get speed bumps on the road as the Baptist Church due to the kids crossing the street to the park.

Arnold Pahchecka 902 West E stated that he would like to see speed bumps on West E because of the speed on that road. Stated that with the new houses in the Cargill addition more cars would be coming up and down that road.




