ANNOUNCEMENTS BY MAYOR AND COUNCIL

Mayor Brown introduced Ashly Slaughterbach as the new Utility Superintendent for the City of Cache. Stated that she brings 20 years of experience and to help him with responsibilities of the city. He said thanks for the great job of the employees that helped with the snow removal. He heard another snow day was coming and to please be patient with us that we will get there.

Councilman Red Elk stated that the neighbors liked the stop sign on 5th street that it helped a lot. Mayor Brown asked if they had any incidents with it and Chief Phelps stated that they had not.

CITIZENS PARTICIPATION:

Venius Dobson from Chamber of Commerce stated that Summer in the Streets would be May 16, 2026, from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. and asked that the streets be blocked at 10 a.m. that morning. Asked for polycarts and picnic tables to be brought up from park. They would not be having a mural contest this year.

Phyllis Meyers – 1 Meyers Lane Stated she had noticed that a lot of home owners do not have utility easements in the back and since the last fire that was behind her area, that there is a gate on her property that you are welcome to use all that she asked is that you please shut the gate for her animals. Councilman Red Elk said that he appreciated that.

Business Items:

Item #2: Motion by Red Elk approved Resolution 2026-01 for PSO to install streetlights on existing poles and add 3 new poles with lights from Crater Creek to Highway 115 on “H” Ave. Second by Runyan.

Item #3: Motion by Red Elk to take no action due to homeowner stating that he had sold the property and closing on the 13th of February. Council stated that from this point on it would be the new homeowner’s responsibility to bring up to code. Second by Runyan.

Item #4: Codie Howell Street Superintendent stated that most all of the culverts would be replaced around the Wildflower circle, would be using some concrete end caps but mostly would be using a large rock for drainage. Council asked about using plastic culverts for the cost and Mr. Howell stated that he would have to look into the cost of that, but council members were concerned about the longevity of the plastic. Motion by Red Elk approval for the Wildflower drainage project not to exceed \$15,000 for culverts and rock. Second by Runyan.


