ORDINANCE NO. 2024-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CACHE, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 11-16 BY REPEALING PARAGRAPH 1; ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH 1; PROVIDING FOR A NEW MUNICIPAL COURT FINE SCHEDULE; INCREASE IN THE FINE ASSESSMENT FEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY,

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to adopt new Municipal Court Fine schedule in accordance with Title 22, Section 1115.3(E), of the Oklahoma Statutes, and has determined it to be in the best interest of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Cache, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1: From and after the effective date, Paragraph 1 of section 11-16, Article 2, Chapter 11 of The Cache City Ordinances shall be repealed.

SECTION 2: From and after the effective date, Paragraph 1 of Section 11-16 Article 2, Chapter of the Cache City Code of ordinances shall be added and adopted to read as follows:

§ 11-16 MUNICIPAL COURT FINES.

1. The following schedule of fines is hereby established:

- a. Traffic Offenses-Base Fees & cost, Minimum fine
 (when other penalty is not provided in statute) Fine: \$249.00
- b. Speeding
 - (1) Minimum Fine (1-10 MPH over limit) Fine: \$100.00
 - (2) 11-15 MPH over limit Fine: \$264.00
 - (3) 16-20 MPH over limit Fine: \$279.00
 - (4) 21-25 MPH over limit Fine: \$319.00
 - (5) 26-30 MPH over limit Fine: \$379.00
 - (6) 31-35 MPH over limit Fine: \$399.00
 - (7) 36- MPH and more over the limit Fine: \$449.00

- c. Speeding in a School Zone/Construction
 - (1) Minimum Fine (1-10 MPH over limit) Fine: \$105.00
 - (2) 11-15 MPH over limit Fine: \$284.00
 - (3) 16-30 MPH over limit Fine: \$314.00
 - (4) 21-25 MPH over limit Fine: \$394.00
 - (5) 26-30 MPH over limit. Fine: \$514.00
 - (6) 31-35 MPH over limit. Fine: \$554.00
 - (7) 36-MPH and more over limit. Fine: \$654.00

- d. Improper Passing Violations
 - (1) Improper Passing on the left. Fine: \$249.00
 - (2) Driving Left of Center Violation. Fine: \$249.00
 - (3) Failure to give way to right when
Being passed. Fine: \$249.00
 - (4) Failure to signal when passing Fine: \$249.00
 - (5) Improper passing on the right Fine: \$249.00
 - (6) Passing without sufficient clearance Fine: \$249.00

Valid driver's license Fine: \$294.00
- f. Failure to obey a lawful traffic control
Sign, signal, device. Fine: \$249.00
- g. Transporting Open Container (TOC) Fine: \$374.00
- h. Seat Belt or Child Restraint Fine: \$20.00
- i. Failure to use child Restraint System Fine: \$269.00
- j. Failure to stop for a school bus loading
or unloading children Fine: \$469.00
- k. Operating a motor vehicle in a manner not
Reasonable and proper Fine: \$294.00
- l. Reckless Driving.
 - (1) First offense Fine: \$512.75
 - (2) Second offense Fine: \$562.75
- m. Non-Commercial drivers operating a vehicle
While using a communication device to compose,
Send or read a text message. Fine: \$254.00
- n. Endangerment of an Emergency Worker



NO FINE SHALL EXCEED STATE STATUTE.

Section 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof. For the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and the welfare of the citizens of the City of Cache, Comanche County, Oklahoma, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
